TWO MANTRAS TAUGHT BY LORD BUDDHA FOR MULTIPLYING THE POWER OF A GOOD DEED, EITHER BEFORE OR AFTER WE DO IT

1) All-purpose mantra for multiplying the good karmic seeds of any good deed we ever do:

Om smara smara, vimanaskara, mahajava huung!

Om I think of You, I think of You! Tear yourself away and come quickly, quickly, hung!

[Sung of course to our Heart Lama, and other holy beings in our life. The technical spelling in Sanskrit, for perfect pronunciation, is: om% smara smara, vimanaskara maha#java hum%)

2) Specific mantra for multiplying the good karmic seeds of bowing down to holy beings and images, and the like:

Om namo Manjushriye, namah sushriye, nama uttama shriye, sva ha!

Om I bow to the glory of Gentle Voice! I bow to that lovely glory! I bow to that glory supreme! *Sva ha!*

[Sung to Manjushri, the Angel of Wisdom. The technical spelling in Sanskrit, for perfect pronunciation, is: om%^ namo man~jus*ri#ye| nama: sus*ri#ye| nama uttamas*ri#ye sva# ha#|]
